HIP Survey Respondents

- Adults = 2241 interviews
 - Washtenaw BRFS = 1962 (87.5%)
 - Michigan BRFS = 237 (10.5%)
 - Chelsea BRFS = 42 (2%)

- 30% of households had children <18 years
- Children by proxy = 633 interviews



MENTAL HEALTH



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


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- 39% of those in fair/poor health seeing MH professional



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- 44% of residents with <HS had 10 or more PPHD






SUBSTANCE ABUSE

 Current smoking decreased over 20%





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- Illicit drug use increased, especially in Ann Arbor
- Drug use interferes with job or home life especially in Ann Arbor
- Females four times more likely to have drugs interfere than males






WEIGHT, NUTRITION, PHYSICAL ACTIVITY




...a mere 206,874 of us are overweight

- Persons with no insurance have more than twice diabetes rates compared to County







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- 27% of uninsured residents have received flu vaccine






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- Sexually high risk behaviors return to 2000 levels




OPPORTUNITY FOR HEALTH: HEALTH EQUITY
